Bianco di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli			
Italy 2006	£12.95	£3.50	£4.50
Made from local Sicilian grape varieties, this great wine is light bodied yet full of ripe fresh fruit flavour. A crisp fresh finish completes the package.			

Robertson Winery Chenin Blanc			
Robertson, South Africa 2007	£15.95		
A pleasant easy drinking wine, with honey sweet aromas and ripe apricot fruit, balanced by zest of grapefruit for an off dry finish.			

Esperanza Sauvignon Blanc			
Mendoza Valley, Argentina 2007	£14.95		
A zesty, clean and aromatic Argentinian Sauvignon Blanc that is fruity yet clean, crisp and refreshing.			

Pinot Grigio IGT Veneto Bacaro			
Italy 2006/07	£15.95		
Made using 100% Pinot Grigio and fermented in stainless steel vats, this wine displays notes of citrus fruits, with a hint of floral aromas.			

Yering Frog Chardonnay			
Yarra Valley, Australia 2006/07	£17.95		
Flavours of intense peach and nectarine dominate the nose. The palate displays refreshing citrus and grapefruit characters backed up with well-integrated French oak.			

Rioja Blanco CVNE, Viña Real			
Spain 2005	£18.95		
A beautifully made white Rioja packed with juicy ripe fruit with hints of cinnamon and a mouth watering, elegant finish.			

Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc			
Marlborough, New Zealand 2007	£18.95		
A classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Ripe and zesty with an exquisite bouquet of fresh gooseberries and a long mouth-watering finish.			

Sancerre 'Les Baudrières', Dominique Baud			
Loire Valley, France 2006	£22.95		
The most famous of all Loire Sauvignons, Sancerre is renowned for its crisp, citrus and gooseberry expression, balanced by restrained elegance. 2005 was an exceptional vintage in the Loire Valley and this wine amply demonstrates the quality of wines produced.			

Chablis, Domaine Servin			
Burgundy, France 2006	£23.95		
A traditionally styled Chablis, sourced from old vines, with the typical steely and flinty edge which Chablis is so famous for.

Rosso di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli			
Italy 2005/06	£12.95	£3.50	£4.50
A warm, rich aroma, followed by classic Italian morello cherry flavours and a light fresh finish.			

Coldridge Estate Shiraz Cabernet			
South Eastern Australia 2005/06	£14.95		
A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours. Spicy Shiraz, lightened by leafy Cabernet Sauvignon, and enriched by a touch of oak.			

Neblina Merlot			
Central Valley, Chile 2006	£15.95		
On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours.			

Castillo Rioja, Bodegas Palacio			
Spain 2005/06	£16.95		
This full-bodied, spicy Rioja is aged in American/French oak for 6 months imparting hints of cinnamon and vanilla.			

Gestos Malbec/Malbec, Finca Flichman, Mendoza			
Mendoza, Argentina 2006	£17.95		
Technically, this wine is a 'Malbec/Malbec' blend - with 50% of the fruit coming from vineyards at 700m above sea level (this fruit gives the ripe plum and prune characteristics) and 50% coming from 1,100m (where the grapes mature more slowly giving intense colour and aromatics). A stunning, complex wine.			

Mâcon Rouge, Les Vignerons des Grandes Vignes			
Burgundy, France 2006	£19.95		
Well-rounded with clean acidity on the finish, this will accompany spicy chicken or red meat dishes perfectly.			

Château du Monthyl, Médoc			
Bordeaux, France 2003	£21.95		
A classic Médoc wine from the famed 2000 vintage. Rich in colour and bouquet, the harmonious palate shows perfect balance between ripe red fruit flavours and well integrated tannins.			

Yering Station Pinot Noir			
Yarra Valley, Australia 2004/05	£27.95		
Black cherry and plum aromas, hints of spice and an intense full and rich palate make this a wine of true class.			

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Lucien Barrot			
Rhône Valley, France 2005	£34.95		
This is a powerful, yet softly structured Châteauneuf. Juicy blackcurrant and blueberry flavours fill the mouth while aromas of leather, smoke and Asian spices fill the nose. Good heady stuff!
